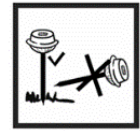


# Instruction Manual

- \* Please remove all packing before using.
- \* Put the switch in the position ON.
- \* Make sure solar lamp stays in direct sun light.
- \* At dusk the lamp automatically switches on.
- \* When the battery is fully charged, the lamp will illuminate for 6 ~ 8 hours.
- \* In winter time and during unfavorable weather this time can be shorter.
- \* If the lamp doesn't work, please check the following:
  - check the solar cell for damage.
  - Make sure the lamp is not in the shadow during the day.
- \* The product is not a toy. Don't let children play within.
